The candidates must forward with his/her application, his /her diploma or other satisfactory evidence of having qualified a degree in this University or of having taken a degree in some other University accepted by the University as equivalent there to. This will be returned to him/her whether he/she passes or fails at the Examination. He/ She should also forward the recognition certificate granted by the University recognizing the Examination passed by him/her , if any. Candidates who passed the B.A. or other Examination in some Other University should also enclose an extract of date of birth as recorded in that University.
07. The Candidate must write his/her name in full in his /her Mother Tongue as well as in English. A woman candidate shall add the Woman. If a change in the name has been recognized by the University, the name under which he/ she has already been enrolled in the University Records should also be given.
08. Candidates must be careful in entering their age. They should furnish the exact dates of their births giving particulars of the day of the Month on which and the year in which they were born as well as their actual age on the date of application. An **entry of date of birth once made shall not be altered, so far as University purposes are concerned and will have to be repeated** at subsequent appearances. The date of birth furnished in this application should be the same as that furnished for the previous University Examination.
09. Candidates are requested to give such a complete address as would ensure any communication by Post reaching them without delay both in term and in vacation.
10. Candidates who are not known or cannot be identified at the Examination Center are advised to take with them to the Examination Hall, certificates of identity from the Principal of the College in which they studied or from the Headmaster of the High School in which they are employed or from a Government Officer of not less than that of a sub-Magistrate.
11. Candidates should obtain their Hall Ticket from the Principal of the B.Ed. College where they studied five days before the commencement of the examination.
12. The Candidates are requested to note that the Supplementary candidates have to take the Supplementary Examination at the same Centers where they have appeared for main Examination.
13. The Examination fee once paid will under no circumstances be refunded or held over for a subsequent examination.

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR EXAMINATIONS

CANDIDATES taking University Examinations are required to observe the following instructions very carefully:

1. Legal suits against University, if any shall be filed in courts within the jurisdiction of Srikakulam only.
2. University reserves the right of allotment of Examination centers to individual candidates as well as college also.
3. Silence should be maintained in the Examination Hall.
4. Candidates should take their places in the Examination Hall at least five minutes before the time fixed for distributing the papers. Candidates will not be allowed to enter the Examination Hall after half an hour of commencement of Examination. Candidates who are undoubtedly suffering from infectious diseases of any kind will not be admitted.
5. Candidates should bring with them their Hall-tickets each day of the Examination for inspection by the chief superintendent/ invigilators.
6. Candidates are prohibited from writing anything on the Hall-tickets and question papers. Candidates are also prohibited from writing their name or any other name unconnected with the answers on any part of their answer books, but they should write their Register numbers very distinctly on the title papers of the main answer book. Failing which, their answer papers may be rejected. They should fill in the subject and the year on the outer cover of the main answer book.
7. Candidates are not allowed to exceed the time assigned to a paper.
8. No candidate will be allowed to leave Examination Hall till the expiry of at least one and half hours after the questions papers are given. Candidates who leaves the Hall during the period allotted for a paper will not be allowed to re-enter the examination hall.
9. Candidates are forbidden to ask questions of any kind during the Examination, if they do so, their answer papers will not be valued and their conduct will be reported to the Monitoring and Development Committee (Executive Council) for disciplinary action.
10. Candidates are not allowed to use books of any kind. They are also prohibited from bringing any material printed or otherwise except the Hall-Tickets into the Examination Hall. Candidates are prohibited from using such extraneous material and communicating with or copying from each other in the Examination Hall and communicating with any person outside the Examination Hall. The candidates are also prohibited from bringing Pagers/Mobile Phones and Cordless Phones into the Examination Hall. Any candidate found violating the instructions will be summarily sent out of the Examination Hall forthwith and his conduct will be reported to the Registrar. Such candidates stand the risk of all their answer papers of the Examinations for which they have appeared may be rejected by the Monitoring and Development committee (Executive Council) and they may be debarred from sitting for the University Examinations till the period decided by the Monitoring and Development Committee (Executive Council).

The use of stencils at the University Examinations is not permitted except students answering papers in Mathematics. The use of Mathematical instruments while answering papers in Mathematics, Engineering, Agriculture and in the Physical Sciences will be allowed. Such instruments will not be supplied by the University.

11. When candidates have finished writing their answers and wish to hand over their answer books, or at the end of the period prescribed for each particular part of the Examination each should stand up at their seats and remain standing until one of the Superintendents/invigilators approaches them and collects his/her answer book.

Any particulars noted in the Hall-tickets differing from those given in the application for the Examination should be immediately reported to the Controller of Examinations, Dr.B.R.Ambedkar University, Srikakulam through the Chief Superintendent concerned.

12. Candidates should bring with them their college identity cards to satisfy the Chief Superintendents of the centers as to their identity.
