Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (GPAT) is a national level entrance exam conducted by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) every year as per the direction of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India. The GPAT is a three hour computer based online test which is conducted in a single session. This test facilitates Institutions to select suitable Pharmacy graduates for admission into the Master's (M. Pharm) program. The GPAT score is accepted by AICTE-Approved Institutions/University Departments/ Constituent Colleges/Affiliated Colleges.

Eligibility

Bachelor's degree holders in Pharmacy (4 years after 10+2, including lateral entry candidates) and those who are in the final year of B. Pharmacy course whose result will be declared before commencement of the admission for academic year 2017-18.
