1) Applications are invited from eligible candidates of Karnataka including the wards of Jammu & Kashmiri Migrants for registration to the "Common Entrance Test-2015" to Professional Courses detailed herein below for the seats to be notified by the Government in the Professional Educational Institutions in the state of Karnataka for the academic year 2015-16.

- NOTE:** (i) The candidate who has obtained a seat in any discipline through KEA (CET Cell) in any of the previous years shall not be eligible to continue in the course to which he / she has been admitted during the previous years immediately upon selection of a seat in any different discipline during the current year.
(ii) The minimum passing marks for all Horanadu and Gadinadu Kannadiga candidates shall be 12 out of 50 marks in Kannada Language Examination conducted by KEA (4th Standard level) in order to be considered for assigning of ranks and to become eligible for allotment of seats in CET-2015.
(iii) In case of Agriculturist Quota, the merit list will be prepared based on 25% marks each, secured in concerned combinations in II year PUC (PCMB) & CET and 50% marks secured in the Practical Test. In case of B.V.Sc & AH merit will be prepared based on 50% of Marks secured in CET (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) and 50% of marks scored in the practical test.

3) How to Apply?

- Step 1:** Enter all the details ONLINE by browsing URL on KEA website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> by selecting "CET-2015 UG Online Application". After completion of entry of all the details, candidates will receive an Application No. and Password to their registered mobile phone number and to email address and also the same information will be displayed on the screen.
Step 2: Upload the scanned copy of recent passport size Colour Photograph, Signature and Left Hand Thumb Impression of candidate and signature of parent in JPG / JPEG format separately.
Step 3: Print the Challan copy which is in triplicate. Candidates of Karnataka origin have to pay a fee amount of **Rs. 650/-** for General and OBC (**Rs.500/-** for SC / ST Category-1 of Karnataka candidates only), **Rs.750/-** in case of candidates residing outside the state of Karnataka and **Rs.5,000/-** in case of candidates residing outside India. The candidates have to pay the requisite fee in any of the branch of State Bank of Mysore, Syndicate Bank, Central Bank of India, Indian Bank, Axis Bank, or Computerized Post Office. The bank / Post Office will retain bank copy of the Challan and handover the student copy and KEA copy of the Challan to the candidates.
*The candidates who are residing outside India shall pay the fees in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Executive Director, Karnataka Examinations Authority, payable at Bangalore, the demand draft should be sent to KEA address by mentioning the online application number on the backside of the Demand Draft along with the copy of the final printout of Application.
Step 4: Take a printout of the filled online application form on A-4 Size paper. Obtain the Principal's seal and signature from the college where you have studied 2nd PUC or 12th Standard or equivalent, on the space provided in the printed form. The same copy should be produced during document verification.

Note: Candidates should note down their Application No. and Password which will be required for all future purposes. Candidates have to enter all the required details in the online application form, failing which their application will not be considered. Applications without Photo and signature will not be considered as valid. Candidates are not allowed to edit their online application after selecting **declaration** / taking the final printout.

Information Brochure can be collected by producing the KEA copy of the Challan in the respective school / colleges where the candidate is studying 2nd PUC or 12th Standard within Karnataka on or after **20-03-2015**. The Information Brochure will be sent to the home address by Speed Post by KEA to the candidates who are residing outside Karnataka.

- Candidates are advised to verify and confirm that they fulfill any one of the Eligibility Clauses updated on the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> and in the e-brochure before applying for admission to Government seats in Professional Colleges in the state of Karnataka for the year 2015. The fee paid by the candidates will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- The information / particulars furnished by the candidates in their CET-2015 online application form will be deemed as "Final" and be the basis for further process. The information furnished in the CET-2015 online application form with regard to Caste / Category and Annual Income remains the same for the purpose of assignment of ranks / selection or allotment of a seat and no change will be entertained in future for any reason.

BRIEF NOTE ON ONLINE SEAT SELECTION

- The seat allotment to the above mentioned courses will be conducted ONLINE by obtaining OPTIONS from the eligible candidates in the order of merit / rank in CET-2015.
- Verification of documents will be done in at least 13 **Notified Helpline Centres** across the state after declaration of results / publication of merit list. The candidate will be permitted to enter the options only upon verification of documents and issue of verification slips. Candidates can enter any number of options of their choice on their own arrangement. The candidates also have a provision to take a print out in each round. Every candidate shall be given high security user ID and Password, which the candidate then has to use to login and then change the password as per his / her choice. The details of Verification Centres will be made available on the Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> and also in the brochure in due course.
- The college and course will be allotted based on their ranking and options and the seats available in a particular college as per the seat matrix issued by the Government. For details refer the CET Brochure - 2015 and also will be notified on the website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> shortly.
- The documents verification of Horanadu / Gadinadu Kannadigas and all Special Categories like Defence, Ex-defence, NCC, Sports, Physically Disabled, Anglo Indian, CAPF, Jammu and Kashmir, Scouts and Guides will be done only in the premises of KEA office at 18th Cross, Malleshwaram, Bangalore.
