ADMISSION TO PROFESSIONAL COURSES IN KARNATAKA FOR THE YEAR 2017-18

1) Applications are invited from eligible candidates of Karnataka including the wards of Jammu & Kashmiri Migrants for registration to the "Common Entrance Test-2017" to Professional Courses detailed herein for the seats to be notified by the Government in the Professional Educational Institutions in the state of Karnataka for the academic year 2017-18.

2) **Academic Eligibility:** As per Rule 5 (1) of Karnataka Selection of Candidates for Admission to Government seats in Professional Educational Institutions Rules, 2006, No candidate shall be eligible for admission to Government Seats unless he is a citizen of India and satisfies any one of the eligibility conditions hosted on the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> The candidates who do not satisfy any of the Clauses / Eligibility Criteria are not eligible for admission to professional courses under Government quota seats through KEA.

SPECIAL NOTE: The candidates have to compulsorily appear for CET-2017 as per their choice of subjects for admission to the courses mentioned against the Sl. No. 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 in the table given below: If they desire only for Medical and Dental (Sl. No. 1) then they have to appear for NEET-2017 and for NATA-2017 to Architecture (Sl. No. 4) Course. But for admission to all the courses through KEA mentioned herein, submission of application online is mandatory.

NOTE: (i) A candidate who had obtained a seat in any discipline through KEA (CET Cell) in any of the previous years and not surrendered the seat before the last date fixed for entry of options for final round of seat allotment for the respective disciplines will not be eligible for allotment of a seat to the same discipline during 2017. However, he / she is eligible to appear for CET-2017 for allotment of seat in any other discipline as per rule 15 (5) of Karnataka Selection of Candidates for Admission to Government seats in Professional Educational Institutions Rules, 2006.

(ii) The minimum passing marks for all Horanadu and Gadinadu Kannadiga candidates shall be 12 out of 50 marks in Kannada Language Examination conducted by KEA (4th Standard level) in order to be considered for assignment of ranks and to become eligible for allotment of seats in CET-2017.

(iii) In the case of Agriculturist Quota, the merit list will be prepared based on 25% marks each, secured in concerned combinations in II year PUC (PCMB) & CET and 50% marks secured in the Practical Test. In case of B.V.Sc & AH merit will be prepared based on 50% of Marks secured in CET (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) and 50% of marks scored in the practical test.

3) How to Apply?

Step 1:	Enter all the details through ONLINE by browsing URL on website http://kea.kar.nic.in by selecting "CET-2017 UG Online Application". After completion of entry of all the details, candidates will receive an application ID and Password to their registered mobile phone number and to email address and also the same information will be displayed on the screen.
Step 2:	Upload the scanned copy of recent passport size Colour Photograph, Signature and Left Hand Thumb Impression in JPG / JPEG format separately.
Step 3:	Print the Challan copy which is in triplicate. In the Challan, the details of the candidate will be pre-printed, such as Name, CET Number, College / Course Allotted details, Fee to be paid, Bank Account Number. Candidates of Karnataka origin have to pay an amount of Rs. 650/- for General and OBC (Rs.500/- for SC / ST Category-1 of Karnataka candidates only). Rs.750/- in case of candidates residing outside the state of Karnataka and Rs.5,000/- in case of candidates residing outside India. The candidates have to pay the requisite fee at e-Post Office / in any of the branch of the Banks specified. The bank / e-post office will retain bank / post office copy of the Challan with them and handover the remaining two copies of the Challan to the candidates. The candidates who are residing outside India shall pay the fees in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Executive Director, Karnataka Examinations Authority, payable at Bangalore, the demand draft should be sent to KEA address by mentioning the application number.
Step-4:	Take a printout of the application form on A-4 Size paper. Obtain Principal seal and signature from the college where you have studied 2nd PUC or 12th Standard on the space provided in the printed form. The same copy should be produced during document verification.

Note: Candidates should note down their application ID and Password until the completion of filling up of the online application. Candidate has to enter all the required details in the form, failing which their application will not be considered. Candidates are not allowed to edit their application after selecting declaration / taking the final printout.

The candidate who fails to upload the Photo / Signature / LTM OR who fails to pay the fees within the prescribed date and time, such candidate's application form will not be considered as valid and they will not be eligible for further process.

Candidates are advised to verify and confirm that they are fulfilling any one of the Eligibility Clauses updated on the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> and also in the brochure before applying for admission to Government seats in Professional Colleges in the state of Karnataka for the year 2017. For any reason the fee paid by the candidates will not be refunded.

The information / particulars furnished by the candidates in their CET - 2017 online application form will be deemed as "Final" and be the basis for further process. The information furnished in the CET-2017 online application form with regard to Caste / Category and Annual Income remains the same for the purpose of assignment of ranks / selection or allotment of a seat and no change will be entertained in future for any reason.

4) As per the seat matrix issued by the Government, the seat allotment to the above mentioned courses will be done **ONLINE by obtaining OPTIONS** from the eligible candidates in the order of merit / rank obtained in 2017 CET / NEET / NATA as applicable, and based on the options given by the candidates.

5) Verification of documents will be done in at least 15 notified helpline centres across the state after declaration of results / publication of merit list. Only upon verification of documents and issue of verification slip, candidate will be allowed to enter the options. Candidates can enter any number of options of their choice on their own arrangement. The candidate also has a provision to take a print out in each round. Every candidate shall be given high security user ID and Secret Key which the candidate then has to login and change it to password as per his / her choice.
