Please note:

- a) Ten minutes extra-time will be allowed from 8.50 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. to read the question paper only. The Officers-in-charge will arrange distribution of question papers accordingly.
- b) Modern Indian Languages (MIL): Assamese, Bengali, Hindi, Bodo, Manipuri, Nepali, Khasi, Garo, Mizo, Hmar and Urdu
- c) There will be separate Question Papers for the subjects Assamese, Bengali, Hindi and Urdu MIL for High Madrassa candidates having 50 marks and time duration 2 hours.
- d) Elective Languages (Time: 3 hrs) and In-Lieu Languages (Time: 2 hrs): There will be common question paper with Groups A and B for each language(viz. Assamese⁴, Bengali⁴, Hindi⁴, Bodo⁴, Manipuri⁴ and Santali) irrespective of elective or lieu language.
- e) Candidates appearing for Elective subject will have to appear in both the groups A & B while candidates appearing for in-lieu language will have to appear in Group A only [which will be treated as Assamese³ (A³), Bengali³ (B³), Hindi³ (H³), Bodo³ (D³), Manipuri³ (M³), and Santali³ (S³) respectively].
