

Karnataka State Eligibility Test (KSET-2015)

Notification 2015

The Karnataka State Eligibility Test (KSET) is an entrance exam conducted in Karnataka by the University of Mysore every year for candidates having the desire to make a career in Lectureship in Karnataka.

KSET is conducting the entrance exam on December 6, 2015. Once the admit card is released all the candidates appearing for the exam can download the same from the official website (kset.uni-mysore.ac.in)

Eligibility criteria

- 1) Candidates who have secured at least 55% of marks (without rounding off) in General category and 50% for SC/ST/PWD-VH/PH/OBC in master's degree or equivalent from universities/institutions recognized by UGC New Delhi, in subjects like Science, Humanities (including languages), Social science, Computer Science & Applications, Electronic science etc., are eligible to appear for this test.
- 2) Candidates who have appeared or will be appearing for the Master's degree examination may also appear for this Test.
- 3) The Ph.D. Degree holders whose Master's degree completed on or before 19th September 1991 are eligible for a relaxation of 5% marks for appearing in KSET examination.

Examination Fee

Examination fee for different categories is as follows,

	Category	Fee
1.	General	Rs. 1000/-
2.	Cat-IIA, IIB, IIIA, IIIB	Rs. 800/-
3.	Cat-I, SC, ST, PWD(VH/PH)	Rs. 500/-

Mode of payment: The examination fee is accepted only through the bank challan.

A late fee of Rs.100/- has to be paid by candidates who submit the online application after the last date till the extended period.

Selection Process

Final selection of the candidates is based on the written test and interview.

Note: The candidates have to carry their admission card to the examination center with photos (attested by the gazetted officer) along with photo ID proof.

Syllabus

Syllabus for K-SET examination will be the same as in UGC/CSIR-NET. Syllabus of all the K-SET subjects can be downloaded from kset.uni-mysore.ac.in/subject-list.
