NOTIFICATION

Sub:- Examinations – Conduct of I to IV Years(New Scheme) BPT course examinations **June/July, 2022** Furnishing of examinations schedule and theory timetable – Regarding.

The schedule for conduct of I to IV Year (New Scheme) BPT course Supplementary theory examinations of **June/July, 2022** is furnished hereunder. The Practical Examinations schedule will be issued Separately. Examination question paper will be sent through **ON LINE** as usual.

In view of the revised scheme of examinations, the following candidates are eligible to appear for BPT University Examinations to be held during **June/July, 2022** subject to fulfilment of conditions like attendance, pass in Internal Assessment, etc.,

1st Year: 1. All First Year failed candidates
2. ***The candidates admitted during the academic year 2013-14 and before are not eligible***

2nd Year: 1. All Second Year failed candidates
2. All the 1st year passed or failed candidates during March, 2021 exams in 1st attempt.
3. ***The candidates admitted during the academic year 2013-14 and before are not eligible***

3rd Year: 1. All Third Year failed candidates
2. All the 2nd year passed or failed candidates during March, 2021 exams in 1st attempt.
3. ***The candidates admitted during the academic year 2013-14 and before are not eligible***

4th Year: 1. All Fourth Year failed candidates.
2. All the candidates those who have passed 1st, 2nd and 3rd year BPT during or before March, 2021 exams
3. All the candidates those who have appeared and passed 3rd year during December, 2021 exams except 1st attempt candidates provided they passed all the subjects in 1st year, 2nd year and 3rd year
4. ***The candidates admitted during the academic year 2013-14 and before are not eligible***

In view of the above, all the Principals of affiliated BPT Colleges of Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences are hereby informed to upload/ forward the Examination applications of eligible candidates only i.e., from 1st year to 4th year New Scheme.

From the 2018-19 admitted batch onwards, e - hall tickets will be issued. The data of 1st to 4th year students who are already registered through UID mode shall also be furnished through the designated portal only.

However, the Principals of OU Region colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences have to submit the list of candidates appearing for 1st to 4th Years (New Scheme) BPT Course examinations in the form of Galley alongwith examination fee in the form of consolidated Demand Draft drawn in favor of the Registrar, Dr.NTR UHS, VJA.

Candidates appearing for University examinations shall not write his/her Name or registered number on any part of the main/additional answer booklet and the candidates shall ensure that the Bar Code OMR sheet issued to the candidate alongwith answer book contains his/her name and registered number and the name of the examination for which the candidate is appearing. After completion of the examination, the candidate shall handover the answer script to the invigilator. These instructions are to be informed to the candidates to be followed scrupulously.

The following is the schedule for submitting examination applications.

Note: Exam applications will not be accepted after 07.05.2022. The Principals are requested to attend in person for submission of Galley, Fee Particulars and NRDF Forms without fail alongwith the application forms before the due date.

Herewith intimated to the students with a direction that all the candidates who are eligible to appear for the examinations according to the BPT course regulations shall submit their applications with requisite examination fee within the stipulated period as stated above.

Dates mentioned above are meant for receipt of applications in Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences office. Earlier dates may be fixed at college level for the submission of applications.

Examination fee per subject is Rs:500/- only. The candidate shall pay Rs.300/- towards Fee for Marks Memorandum for each year. Candidates appearing IV Year (NS) shall pay 400/- towards fee for Provisional Certificate in addition to the exam fee and marks memo fee.

Amount towards examination fee and Marks Memo has to be sent in the form of consolidated single Demand Draft drawn in favor of the Registrar, Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada. Detailed information regarding the examination fee paid by each student, No. of subjects he/she wants to appear and the Marks Memo fee paid by each student should be furnished. DDs shall be drawn from Nationalized Banks only.

Filled-in application forms/details of the eligible candidates shall be forwarded to the University office well in advance within the due date.

All the Principals of the affiliated Physiotherapy colleges are requested to furnish subjectwise attendance particulars of each candidate alongwith the dates of their admission. **The candidates must have put in minimum 80% of attendance. The Candidate with 75% attendance may also apply alongwith a condonation fee of Rs.100/- per subject.** Hence, such students having attendance between 75% to 79% should submit their applications duly accompanied by condonation fee of Rs.100/- per subject with due recommendation of the Principal.

In no case, change of attendance shall be accepted later.

List of eligible candidates will be provided by the University in the form of Nominal Rolls.

Nominal Roll Demand Forms (NRDF) will be supplied by the University to furnish the names of deleted candidates and addition of candidates from the Nominal Rolls.

Nominal Roll Demand Forms duly filled and signed by the Principal shall be returned to the University alongwith examination application forms.

Deletions:

If any candidate is not willing to appear for the examinations or who is not eligible to appear for the examinations and whose name appears in the printed Galley from I to IV Years BPT course examinations provided by the University, such candidates may be **deleted from the Galley with Red ink by drawing a round circle against them.** The information of list of deleted candidates is also to be furnished in respective NRDF – DB forms as stated below with reasons in the remarks column. The NRDF-DB forms with final list of candidates eligible to appear for the examinations are to be forwarded to the University before due date prescribed in the notification.

1st Year BPT course – NRDF – DBY1

2nd Year BPT course – NRDF – DBY2

3rd Year BPT course – NRDF – DBY3

4th Year BPT course – NRDF – DBY4

Additions:

If any candidate is eligible to appear for the examinations and whose name is not shown in the galley (I to IV Years) provided by the University, the Principals are requested to furnish the list of such candidates with justification for adding, in remarks column in respective NRDF – AB forms as stated below and to forward to the University with certification before due date prescribed in the Notification.

1st Year BPT course – NRDF - ABY1

2nd Year BPT course – NRDF - ABY2

3rd Year BPT course – NRDF - ABY3

4th Year BPT course – NRDF - ABY4

It is also requested that the following details shall be furnished to the undersigned well in advance, i.e., on receipt of this notification.

1. The list of candidates applying for the examination subject wise.
2. Advance and stationery requirements (with detailed anticipatory expenditure statement) for conduction of examinations shall be furnished. However, no fresh advance will be sanctioned unless previous advance is settled. Principals should submit the detailed expenditure within 15 days of completion of the examinations.
3. Subject wise Internal Assessment marks of all eligible regular and referred candidates should be furnished on or before 20.05.2022 positively through the designated portal or in printed OMR Sheets only provided by the University (for 4th year students). The internal assessment marks and attendance particulars once furnished and entered in Medhas portal shall be final and no changes whatsoever shall be entertained afterwards.

Attendance particulars of all exam-going students should be furnished duly giving registration number of each candidate and should be furnished separately with separate covering letters.

4. If any change in the results of the candidate applied for Re-totaling of theory marks awarded is found by the verifying committee constituted by the University, it will be intimated to such candidates through the Principal of the concerned colleges. No separate intimation will be sent to the candidates who applied for Re-totaling of marks awarded.
5. In view of introduction of digital valuation which ensure fair valuation. Interested students may apply for re-totaling to the University personal verification/identification is not required.

SINGLE ANSWER BOOKLETS:

Digital Valuation System is being implemented for BPT Course theory examinations from September, 2019 Examinations onwards. Hence, all the students will be given answer booklets with 48 writable pages only henceforth for all examinations. No additional booklets will be given. All the Principals are directed to inform the same to all the students without fail duly displaying prominently in all the notice boards.
