1. The HoDs of concerned Departments may forward the applications for examinations along with chalan receipts and statement of fees to the Controller of Examinations on or before the last date prescribed.

2. Database of the candidates duly authenticated by the HoD are to be forwarded along with originals of Degree Certificate/Provisional Certificate and Consolidated Grade card/Mark List. In the case of candidates who qualified from universities outside Kerala, Equivalency Certificates issued by the Kannur University are to be enclosed. Those qualified from Universities other than Kannur University, should forward application and fee for Matriculation and Recognition.

3. The APCs forwarded by the HoD should be in the prescribed format. A general statement to the effect that 'all candidates possess required percentage of attendance' etc., will **NOT** be accepted.

4. HoDs are to certify to the effect that:-

a) Admissions to the respective PG Programme have been made strictly as per the criteria prescribed by the University and the Government.

b) Fees have been claimed in respect of those candidates who are eligible for fee concession and the same will be remitted to the University account immediately on release of grants.

5. Candidates with shortage of attendance will not be issued Hall Tickets unless the HoD recommends and states that the shortage is within condonable limit and the applications for condonation have been forwarded to the Registrar.
